INTRODUCTION

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report aims to examine the diversity of composers represented in music lists recommended, prescribed, or required by states during the 2022-2023 school year. We focused on two primary categories of composers who have been historically marginalized and excluded: **women composers and composers of color**, as well as the music of **living composers** from all ethnicities and gender identities.

According to Elpus & Abril's report in 2019, almost half (42%) of school ensembles consist of students representing non-white and non-men categories and intersectionalities. Recent research by Deemer & Meals in 2022 highlights a positive trend in the increased recognition of works by composers from these backgrounds in professional settings. Connecting them meaningfully to students' school music experience is vital to the continued improvements to representational parity in music, making the diversity of recommended, required, and prescribed music lists a significant catalyst in this ongoing progress.

We analyzed lists of 40,409 choral works from 17 states. These lists included 15,029 unique works by 3,499 composers.

- Works composed by men made up 77% of the lists, while **works composed by women made up 16.8%**.
- Works by white composers made up 88.1% of the lists, while **works by composers of color made up only 5.7%**.
- **Works by living composers made up 45.4%** of the lists, while works by deceased composers made up 49.1%.

Works composed by white men made up the largest share of any intersectional group, at 71.9% of the total works. Works composed by men of color made up 5.1%, while works by white, women composers made up 16.3%. **Works by women composers of color made up less than one percent (0.5%)** of the composite lists.

Composers of color and women composers account for 22.5% of unique composers, and only 20.6% of unique titles. White men account for 71.4% of all unique composers and 78.9% of unique titles. These numbers do not add to 100% as there were many works derived from songs where composers were not attributed (ex. "Traditional").

METHODOLOGY & DEFINITIONS

- The mission of ICD is to encourage the discovery, study, and performance of music written by composers from historically excluded groups. To this end, the focus of this summary report is on the primary creator of each work—usually the original composer, but in certain cases where the original creator is unknown (ex. "Traditional"), the arranger has been counted as the creator of the distinct work.
- Arrangers have not been counted if the primary creator of the work was known and labeled in the state lists for the sake of an even "apples-to-apples" comparison throughout this report as well as consistency between this report and the other NFHS repertoire reports.
- Attributions reflect original state list designations. Composer names were adjusted to normalize spelling, but inconsistencies in attribution reflect differences within and between state lists.
- The terms "men" and "women" include composers who identify as men or women.
- In order to efficiently analyze the various datasets, ICD uses a coding system to label the demographic category of each composer:

1 = Living White Men	6 = Deceased White Women
2 = Living White Women	7 = Deceased Men of Color
3 = Living Men of Color	8 = Deceased Women of Color
4 = Living Women of Color	9 = Living Non-Binary
5 = Deceased White Men	999 = Unknown

- Additional coding allowed for us to delineate composers of color by several different demographic categories (Black/

African-American, Latinx/Latin American, East Asian, Southeast Asian, South Asian, West Asian/North African, Pacific Islander, Indigenous, and Intersectional).

- Initial coding of historically excluded composers began with the Composer Diversity Database, housed within the Institute for Composer Diversity’s website, which lists information for 2,500 composers. All living composer information is self-reported.
- For composers who did not appear in these sources, we followed the following protocols to identify their likely membership (listed in descending order of precision and reliability).
 - Where gender identity was unknown, we used pronouns found in each composer’s official biography or other historical analysis.
 - Where ethnic or racial identity was unknown and historical records were inconclusive, we investigated descriptive language (coded or explicit) describing the composer.
 - Where historical status was unknown, we approximated their likely status by applying the length of a standard lifespan to the composer’s birth year (or reasonable range of years).
- Any composers that we could not identify through existing records or resources were coded as “Unknown” in our data.
- There may be instances of the same piece being listed multiple times in the list (indicating either the entire work or a single movement); we have counted each as its own data point.
- We acknowledge that using broad categories to define gender identity, as well as racial and ethnic identity, oversimplifies the rich and varied experiences that shape each person’s unique identity. Additionally, we acknowledge that the absence of detailed analysis of historically excluded and marginalized communities including composers within and across the LGBTQIA2S+ as well as the Disabled, d/Deaf, and Neurodivergent communities omits many important dimensions of the human experience. We ask that the broad categories included within be viewed as a consequence of the summary

nature of this report rather than a lack of recognition, respect, and care for the full diversity and complexity of composers from historically underrepresented and excluded communities.

2023 STATE LIST DETAILS

COMPOSERS FROM HISTORICALLY EXCLUDED GROUPS / LIVING COMPOSERS

Key Points

- The overrepresentation of composers from certain demographic groups in state repertoire lists can be viewed through several overlapping lenses. Primary among these is to consider the proportion of white men to all other historically excluded groups (see *Figure 1*), which illustrates the enormous majority of programmed performances commanded by this demographic group.
- *Figure 2* highlights the relatively even proportions between living and deceased composers within the state repertoire lists. This varies somewhat between large ensemble genres; while band and choral lists were relatively balanced between living and deceased composers, orchestral lists still skewed toward works by deceased composers.

WOMEN COMPOSERS / COMPOSERS OF COLOR

Key Points

- ICD suggests a proportional goal of 16% for women composers and 16% for composers of color both in annual programming and state repertoire lists.
- The proportion between works composed by women and men is very strong compared to that of composers of color to white composers. As will be shown on the next page, a very small amount of that 16.8% (.5% to 16.3%) is made up of works by women of color.
- Choral list work proportions compared favorably to Band and Orchestra Lists in regard to women composers (3.7% for Band and 5.7% for Orchestra) and composers of color (4.2% for Band and 2.8% for Orchestra).

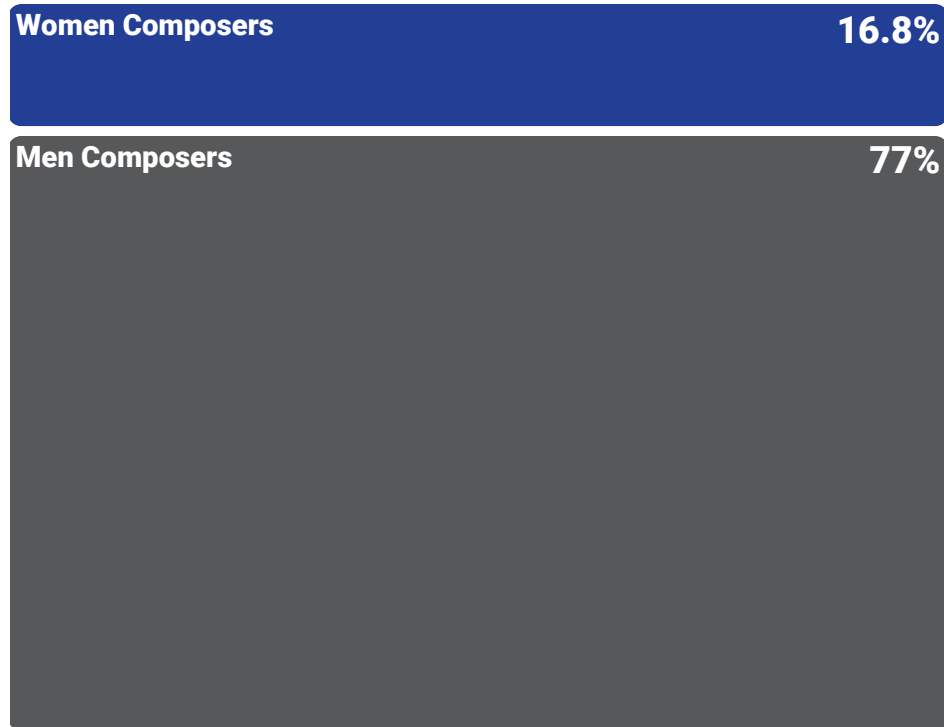


Fig. 3: Comparison of works by women and men within the aggregated NFHS State Choral Repertoire Lists.

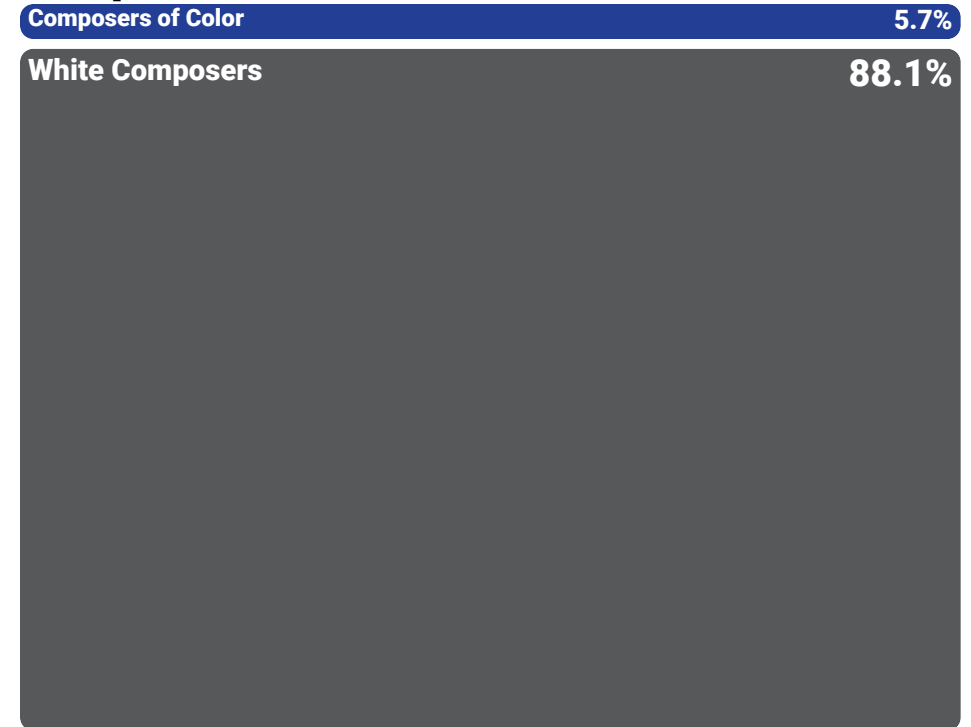


Fig. 4: Comparison of works by composers of color and white composers within the aggregated NFHS State Choral Repertoire Lists.

2023 STATE LIST DETAILS

OVERALL PROPORTIONS BY DEMOGRAPHIC GROUPS

Key Points

- Overall the proportion of works by white men to women composers and composers of color is **better** than the ICD benchmark goals (71.9% vs. our suggested maximum goal of 76%); these distribution benchmarks are listed (see p.10 for more about our suggested benchmarks).
- The balance of composers from underrepresented composers is mixed. White women are over twice as much as our minimum benchmark goals at 16.3%. Men of color are at over halfway to our recommended minimum goal of 8% at 5.1%. Women of color, however, are **practically nonexistent** at 0.5% (compared to our recommended minimum of 8%) and should definitely be a major area for focus when adding new works to the lists.

Out of 40,409 works, 211 were by women of color, 2,080 by men of color, 6,568 by white women, and 29,039 by white men. 1,552 works were by Black composers, 384 by Latinx composers, 102 by East Asian composers, and 86 works by composers from other racial/ethnic demographic groups. Any composers for whom we could not confirm racial/ethnic identity were coded as “unknown”.

BREAKDOWNS BY GENDER & RACE/ETHNICITY

Key Points

- Compared to wind band repertoire lists, where there is a significant emphasis on works by composers from the 20th and 21st centuries, choral repertoire lists show a balance between living and deceased composers—as long as those composers were either white or men or both.
- When considering the long history of choral repertoire, it is worth noting that these lists show a higher degree of diversity across all categories than their instrumental counterparts. However, given the nature of systemic marginalization and exclusion before the second half of the Twentieth century, expectations for deceased composers from underrepresented groups should be tempered.

Breakdown of works by living and deceased composers by gender

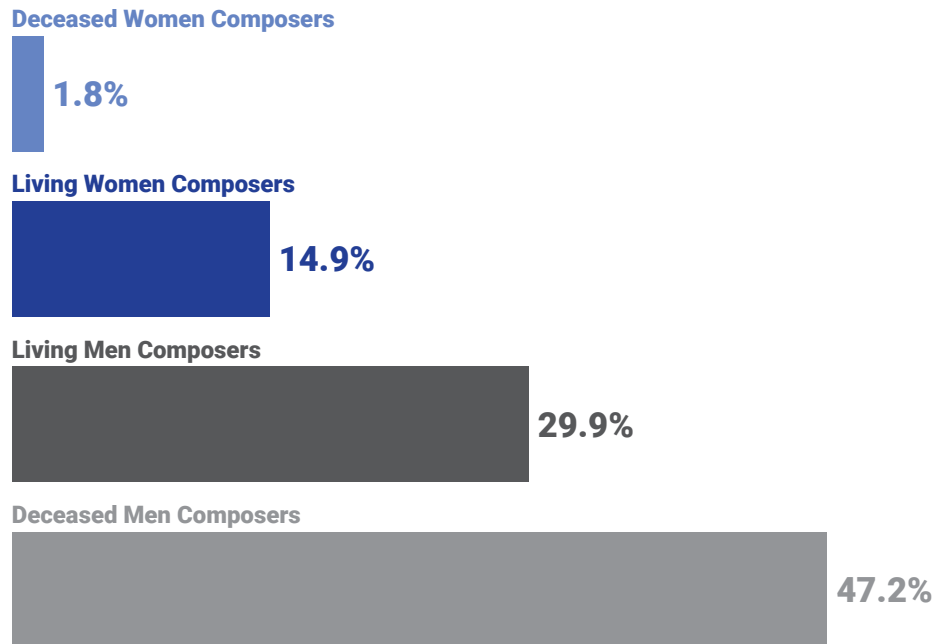


Fig. 6: A comparison of programmed works by living composers, organized by demographic membership.

Breakdown of works by living and deceased composers by race/ethnicity

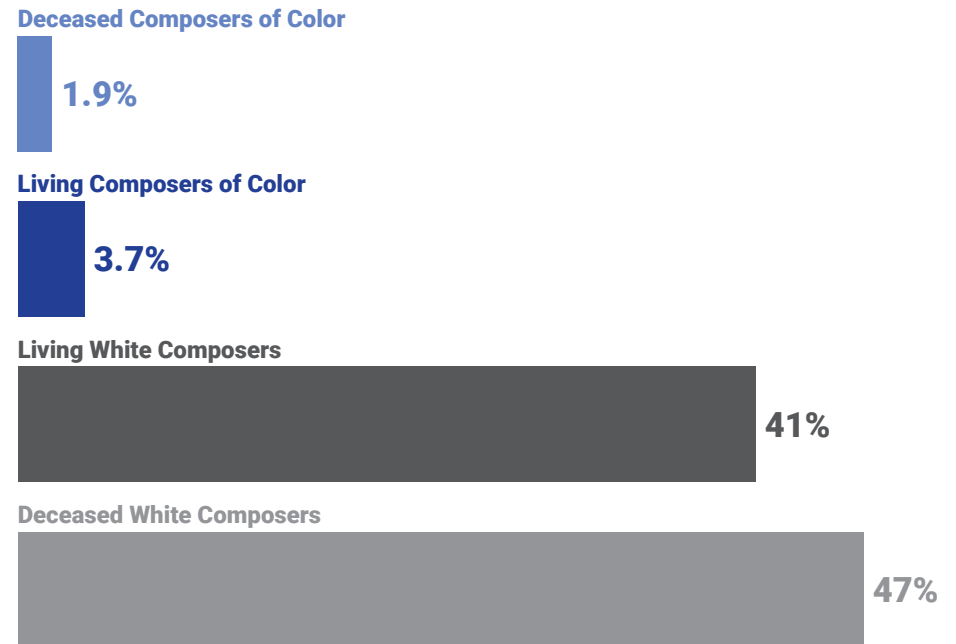


Fig. 7: A comparison of programmed works by deceased composers, organized by demographic membership.

2023 STATE LIST DETAILS

COMPARING TOTAL WORKS / UNIQUE WORKS / UNIQUE COMPOSERS

Key Points

- The analysis of unique individual titles and unique composers reveals a much more balanced trend to those of the total works. However, it is worth noting that the distribution of unique white men and all other groups shows a complex relationship when we examine total presence across lists.
- Composers of color and women composers account for 22.5% of unique composers and 21.9% of total works. White men account for 71.4% of all unique composers and 71.9% of total works. This suggests that there are more white men who have a disproportionately large number of works in state repertoire lists than those composers belonging to underrepresented groups.

Comparison of total works, unique titles, and unique composers between white men and composers from historically excluded groups

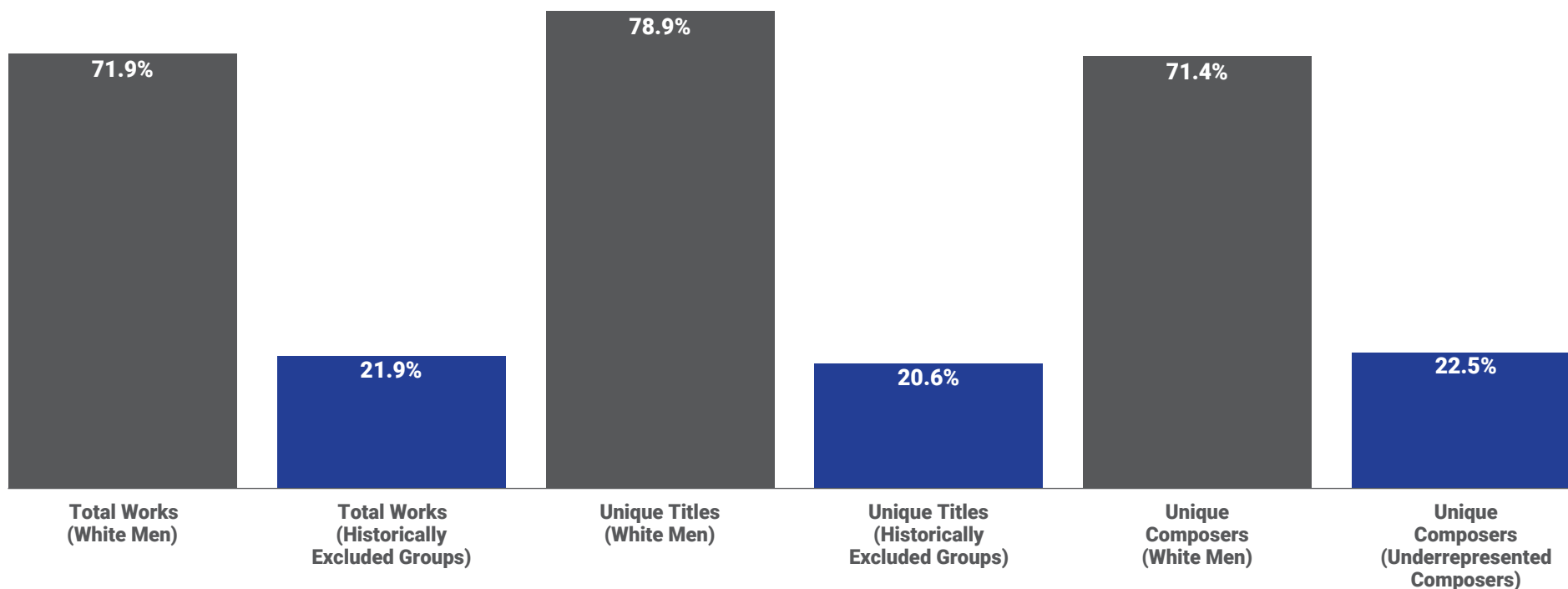


Fig. 8: A comparison of total works, unique titles, and unique composers between various demographic groups. A total of 40,409 works were found in the NFHS State Choral Repertoire Lists with 15,029 unique titles and 3,499 unique composers. 786 of those composers were from historically excluded groups having created 3,094 unique titles.

Comparing # of state lists composers are included in vs. # of titles included on state lists nationally (Top 15 listed composers & Top 15 underrepresented composers)

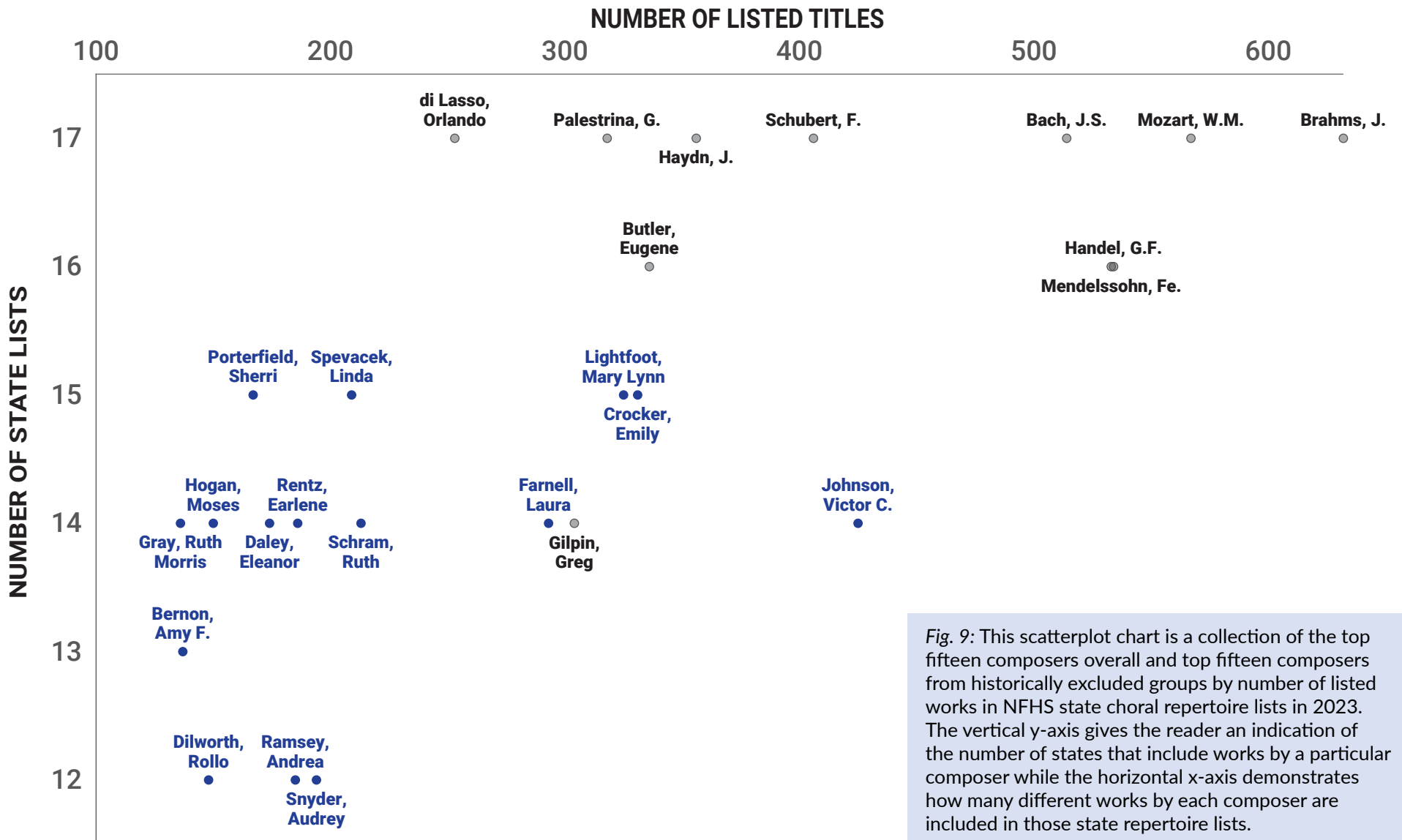


Fig. 9: This scatterplot chart is a collection of the top fifteen composers overall and top fifteen composers from historically excluded groups by number of listed works in NFHS state choral repertoire lists in 2023. The vertical y-axis gives the reader an indication of the number of states that include works by a particular composer while the horizontal x-axis demonstrates how many different works by each composer are included in those state repertoire lists.

BEST PRACTICES

Suggested Benchmarks

- ICD has been considering appropriate minimum benchmarks for programming for several years, and the information below outlines suggested achievable proportions to aim for as minimum goals in annual concert programming. These concepts are not genre-specific and can be mapped onto almost any seasonal programming model.
- Note: When programming with benchmarks in mind, it is important to do so within the context of the best programming practices described above to create a sustainable and long term investment in a new way of programming rather than a performative way that meets a numerical goal without further intention.
- We encourage setting 24% as a minimum goal for works by composers from historically-excluded groups; this goal should further distributed equally with 8% each for works composed by women of color, men of color, and white women whenever possible.
- Similarly, we encourage setting 24% as a minimum goal for works by living composers
- For single-concert events (such as an All-State or All-National festival for K-12 educators), ICD suggests that at least one work by a woman composer and at least one work by a composer of color be included in each ensemble’s concert, if possible.

Key Points

- The various methods of adjustments listed below are to provide states with options to diversify their required repertoire lists.
- The **Adjusted #'s** option assumes the state would like to keep their overall total numbers in the category the same and how much adjustments there would need to be in each demographic category in order to achieve that goal (including removing works by white men).
- The **Additive #'s** option assumes that the state chooses to keep the current number of works by white men the same while increasing the number of works by composers in the other demographic groups.
- The **Growth #'s** option assumes the state will choose to increase works in all demographic categories and displays an example of what those resulting numbers would look like (if the number of added works by white men was fewer or greater than indicated below, the resulting numbers in the other demographic groups would be lower or higher in comparison).
