INTRODUCTION

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report aims to examine the diversity of composers represented in music lists recommended, prescribed, or required by states during the 2022-2023 school year. We focused on two primary categories of composers who have been historically marginalized and excluded: **women composers and composers of color**, as well as the music of **living composers** from all ethnicities and gender identities.

According to Elpus & Abril's report in 2019, almost half (42%) of school ensembles consist of students representing non-white and non-men categories and intersectionalities. Recent research by Deemer & Meals in 2022 highlights a positive trend in the increased recognition of works by composers from these backgrounds in professional settings. The journey and accomplishments of these composers, musicians, and conductors testify to their artistic strength and authenticity. Connecting them meaningfully to students' school music experience is vital to the continued improvements to representational parity in music, making the diversity of recommended, required, and prescribed music lists a significant catalyst in this ongoing progress.

We analyzed lists of 18,063 orchestral works from 12 states. These lists included 7,783 unique works by 1,315 composers.

- Works by men made up 91.2% of the lists, while works by women made up only 5.7%.
- Works by white composers made up 94.1% of the lists, while works by composers of color made up only 2.8%.
- Works by living composers made up 24% of the lists, while works by deceased composers made up 72.9%.

Works by white, men composers made up the largest share of any intersectional group, at 90% of the total works. Works by men composers of color made up 1.2%, while works by women composers of color made up 1.5% and works by white women composers made up 4.1% of the composite lists.

Composers of color and women composers account for 11.9% of unique composers, but only 8.4% of total works. White men account for 83.6% of all unique composers and 90% of total works.

PROGRAMMING DATA: CODING

• In order to efficiently analyze the various datasets, ICD uses a coding system to label the demographic category of each composer:

1 = Living White Men	6 = Deceased White Women
2 = Living White Women	7 = Deceased Men of Color
3 = Living Men of Color	8 = Deceased Women of Color
4 = Living Women of Color	9 = Living Non-Binary
5 = Deceased White Men	999 = Unknown

- Initial coding of historically excluded composers began with the Composer Diversity Database, housed within the Institute for Composer Diversity's website, which lists information for 2,400 composers including over 1540 living composers. All living composers' information is self-reported.
- After checking the ICD database for self-reported identity markers, we set about creating initial categorization of the remaining composers found within the programming data.
- For composers who did not appear in these sources, we followed the following protocols to identify their likely membership (listed in descending order of precision and reliability).
 - Where gender identity was unknown, we used pronouns found in each composer's official biography or other historical analysis.
 - Where ethnic or racial identity was unknown and historical records were inconclusive, we investigated descriptive language (coded or explicit) describing the composer.
 - Where historical status was unknown, we approximated their likely status by applying the length of a standard lifespan to the composer's birth year (or reasonable range of years).
- Any composers that we could not identify through existing records or resources were coded as "Unknown" in our data.

2023 STATE LIST DETAILS

HISTORICALLY EXCLUDED COMPOSERS / LIVING COMPOSERS Key Points




Fig. 1: Comparison of works by women composers and composers of color and works by white men composers within the aggregated NFHS State Orchestra Repertoire Lists.

- The overrepresentation of white, deceased, and men composers in state repertoire lists can be viewed through several overlapping lenses. Primary among these is to consider the proportion of white men to all other historically excluded groups (see *Figure 1*), which illustrates the enormous majority of programmed performances commanded by this demographic group.
- Figure 2 highlights the relatively even proporions between living and deceased composers within the 2023 programmed performances.
- There may be instances of the same piece being listed multiple times in the list (indicating either the entire work or a single movement); this is the case with composers from all demographics, so we decided to count each as its own data point.

WOMEN COMPOSERS / COMPOSERS OF COLOR Key Points

- ICD suggestions a proportional goal of 16% for women composers and 16% for composers of color both in annual programming and state repertoire lists.
- Figures 3 & 4 (seen below) are stark indicators of how far state repertoire lists have to acheive these suggested goals. Out of a total of 18,063 works, only 1022 were composed by women composers and 501 were composed by composers of color.
- For context, the NFHS State Band Repertoire List Report finds that these proportions are very similar between both genres; band works by women composers were found to be at 3.7% while orchestral works by composers of color were at 4.2%.

OVERALL PROPORTIONS BY DEMOGRAPHIC GROUPS Key Points

- Overall the proportion of works by white men to women composers and composers of color is **higher** than ICD recommends (89.9% vs. our recommended level of 76%).
- The balance of works by white women are at about halfway to our recommended minimum of 8%. Women and men of color, however, are **extremely low** at 1.5% and 1.3% respectively (compared to our recommended minimum of 8%) and should definitely be a major area for focus when adding new works to the lists.

Out of 18,063 works, 276 were by women of color, 225 by men of color, 746 by white women, and 16,250 by white men. 303 works were by by East Asian composers, 121 by Black composers, 74 by Latinx composers, , and 3 works by composers from other racial/ethnic demographic groups. Any composers that we could not identify through existing resources were coded as "Unknown" in our data.

BREAKDOWNS BY GENDER & RACE/ETHNICITY Key Points

- Since orchestral repertoire in general places a significant emphasis on works by composers from the 18th, 19th, and early 20th centuries, it is not overly surprising that the discrepancy between living and deceased composers.
- That being said, if efforts are made to diversify orchestral repertoire lists with more works by women composers and composers of color, these living/deceased proportions will improve since the large majority of composers in those groups are still living. Finally, there are still a sizeable number of works by historically and artistically significant composers of color and women composers from the 19th and early 20th century which should be considered when reorganizing repertoire lists.




Fig. 18: A comparison of programmed works by deceased composers, organized by demographic membership.

COMPARING TOTAL WORKS / UNIQUE WORKS / UNIQUE COMPOSERS Key Points

- The analysis of unique individual works and unique composers reveals a similar trend to those of the total works. However, it is worth noting that the distribution of unique white men and all other groups shows an complex relationship when we examine total presence across lists.
- In other words, composers of color and women composers account for 11.9% of unique composers, but only 8.4% of total works. White men account for 86% of all unique composers and 90% of total works. This suggests that in addition to being disproportionately represented compared to overall diversity, white men are also overrepresented on a per capita basis. Comparison of total works, unique titles, and unique composers between white men composers, women composers, and composers of color





Fig. 15: A comparison of of total works, unique titles, and unique composers between various demographic groups. A total of 18,063 works were found in the NFHS State Orchestra Repertoire Lists with 7,803 unique titles and 1,315 unique composers. Only 157 composers were from underrepresented groups comprising 89 women composers and 68 composers of color.

BEST PRACTICES

Key Points

- The various methods of adjustments listed below are to provide states with options to diversify their required repertoire lists.
- The **Adjusted #'s** option assumes the state would like to keep their overal total numbers in the category the same and how much adjustments there would need to be in each demographic category in order to acheive that goal (including removing works by white men).
- The **Additive #'s** option assumes that the state chooses to keep the current number of works by white men the same while increasing the number of works by composers in the other demographic groups.
- The **Growth #'s** option assumes the state will choose to increase works in all demographic categories and displays an example of what those resulting numbers would look like (if the number of added works by white men was fewer or greater than indicated below, the resulting numbers in the other demographic groups would be lower or higher in comparison).
